For your reference I have attached RI's policies for RAGs, along with guidelines for use of the Rotary name and emblem. If you decide to develop a logo, please check with us first so we can confirm that it meets RI's requirements for use of the Rotary Marks. As you begin producing promotional publications and messages, please be mindful of these policies and feel free to consult with me if you have any questions; I am always happy to advise you. I understand that a draft website has been developed at http://www.roisight.org/cs_test/ and I plan to provide feedback to Stephen in a separate message.

RAGs are free to contact district governors and district governors-elect, and in a separate message I will provide Mark with contact lists to use for this purpose. RAGs may not send broadcast email communications to other Rotarians, outside their own membership, unless Rotarians have either voluntarily opted in to receive such information, or their district governor has granted the RAG express permission to reach out to their clubs.

Every year, RAGs must submit an annual report and financial statement to RI by 1 October. We will send you an annual report form to use next year as the deadline approaches. RAGs must distribute a newsletter (electronic or print) to their members at least once per year. Please add our staff email address, actiongroups@rotary.org, to your newsletter distribution list so that our records are kept current, and so we can stay up to date on your group's activities and promote them through Rotary media channels.

All RAGs now have the opportunity to apply for one gratis booth space at the 2013 RI Convention in Lisbon, Portugal. I will forward Mark a separate message with details on how to apply.

Getting a new RAG off the ground can be challenging, but my colleagues and I are here to help. Please don't hesitate to contact us if you have any questions.
